Honor Is Due – Romans 13:7

We are to respect authority and give honor where it is due. Stiff-necked rebellious people destroy society. They cause trust to be lost and fear to control peoples lives. Civilized society, like the Israelites, were told to get rid of such people. Deuteronomy 21:18-21 commands a stubborn rebellious son that does not obey his parents to be executed by the city authorities. We think of that as harsh. But have we noticed how many humble, obedient sons or daughters end up in jail? Not many. Most criminals are those who reject authority and do not honor anyone but themselves. If that! We as individuals, and as a body of believers are to show respect and honor. Just as Exodus 20:12 commands children to honor their parents.

Today, among many we honor, we want to single out our great appreciation for the dedicated leadership Al and Frances Stroop have given to this congregation over many, many years.
