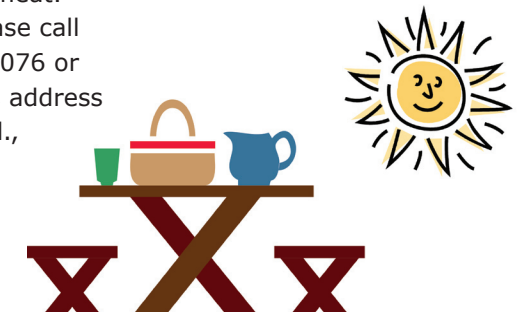
Annual Picnic!

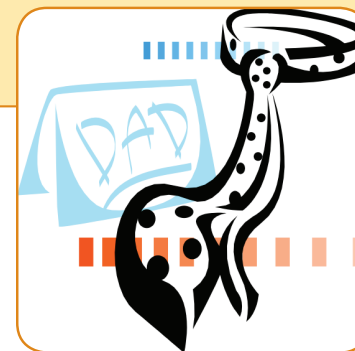
Father’s Day should be a joy. A celebration. A feast.
