Clyde Johnson – called and wanted to let the congregation know that the doctors have told him that they have found more cancer and that there is nothing they can do to treat it. They have also found a blood clot that they plan on putting in a filter for. There is also some other tests they want to do. The doctors have not given him a timeline at this time. Clyde has asked that we pray for his family.

Update on the Greenwoods – We are glad to say that we may be home soon! Yippee! Michael's doctor is optimistic that he can be released before the end of this month. So we may get to worship God together on the last Sunday of February. As a bone marrow transplant patient, Michael's immune system will take up to 2 years (i.e. end of 2011) to get back to normal.

For the near term, he needs the cooperation of everyone so he can stay healthy. He is not allowed to have physical contact (no handshakes or hugs) with anybody outside his immediate family. If you have a cold, cough or the flu, please keep your distance from Michael. He is also not to be near people who have been recently vaccinated with "live" viruses such as H1N1, flu, MMR, polio and any nasal spray vaccinations. Michael's baby vaccinations will have to be repeated over the next 2 years so his resistance to any infection is extremely low. For example, he is not allowed to do yard work for one year and we won't have any indoor plants or flowers. He is also not to be in physical contact with children under 12 (except for his own kids, if they are healthy). He will try to be about six feet away from everyone so a wave and a shout of greeting will warm his heart greatly.

If you see someone wearing a mask, you'll know that it's Michael and not the Lone Ranger! :) The surgical mask is necessary for the next few months. We appreciate your cooperation, love and prayers.
