Status Symbols

"I won't do that, it's beneath me." This phrase has been uttered many times over the years to indicate that our perceived social status is too high for us to participate in certain lowly tasks. It is common for us to rank people, including ourselves, into different levels of importance and treat them accordingly. Favoritism results as we court the important and disparage the bottom dwellers. This is, after all, the way of the world.

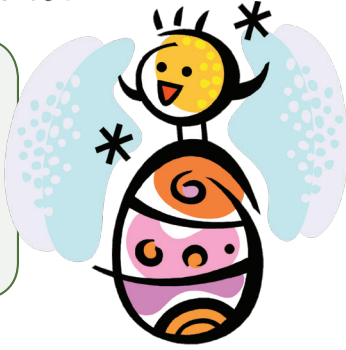

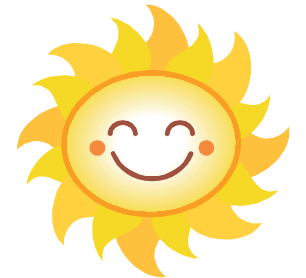
