Their work in India is concentrated in the Rampachodavaram-Tuni areas of Andhra Pradesh State in southeast India. It covers a 400 square mile area between the cities of Kakinada and Visakhapatnam and extends from those coastal cities inland into the rugged Ghat Mountains. This region is inhabited by 80 million people, many of whom are receptive to the gospel and have accepted the Lord Jesus as their personal savior.

Praise God and pray for our Indian brothers and sisters who have turned to Him from their former Hindu gods. Also pray for Jack and all the workers who are teaching the Gospel in India.
